Types of Child Care in New York State

Modalities of Care

Legally Exempt

Parent receives DSS subsidies for payment

No more than 2 unrelated children in the provider's home

Family/Group Family

Family- 1 adult with 6-8 children based on ages

Group Family-2 adults for 10-16 children based on ages

Must be in a residential home

Child Care Center and School Age

Held in a commercial building and serves children more than 3 hours a day
