



What is the Fair Housing Act?

A federal law that prohibits housing discrimination based on an individual's protected class

Who does the FHA protect?

The FHA protects individuals from discrimination based on their:

- Race
- Color
- Religion
- National Origin
- Sex
- Disability
- Family Status

Note: It also covers persons perceived as or associating with others of the above noted protected classes.

Sex

- ▶ Refers to an individual's gender.
- Affords protection to victims of domestic violence against housing discrimination
- Affords protections against sexual harassment in housing
- Affords protection against maternity leave discrimination in housing transactions
