## What is HPOG?

The Health Profession Opportunity Grants (HPOG) Program was established by the Affordable Care Act of 2010 (ACA) to provide education and training programs in high-demand health care professions to Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) recipients and other low-income individuals.

## What is our Mission?

ROC-HPOG, in collaboration with community partners, promotes and provides opportunities to train and educate individuals with low-income and TANF recipients to enter employment in the healthcare field and become self-sufficient.

## Who can apply?

Every Monroe County Resident interested in working in health care, who is 18 years old and within the income\* eligibility guidelines.

\*At or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level for TANF recipients and individuals with low income, and at or below 250% of the Federal Poverty Level for incumbent health care workers.

## Programs & Services

With the guidance and support from our HPOG Navigators, each program participant will create a plan that will serve as a road map to ensure a successful transition into a career in healthcare. HPOG Navigators provide additional program services such as referrals to partnering programs and supportive services in the following areas:

- Healthcare job training
- Basic skills education / Soft skills training
- High School Equivalency/TASC
- Work Readiness
- Navigation & Case management
- Individualized support

In addition to support, participants may receive monetary assistance\* in the following areas:

- Books
- Supplies
- Tutoring
- Testing Fees
- License Fees
- Uniforms
- Tuition Assistance

\*Funding not guaranteed and is awarded on an individual basis. Information pertaining to trainings and services offered may be subject to change.

## Education & Training

Training is organized as a series of manageable steps leading to successively higher credentials and employment opportunities. Participants may elect to train in a range of health care occupations with our various partners including but not limited to:

- Community Health Worker

- Emergency Medical Technician
- Home Health Aide
- Pharmacy Aide

- Medical Billing & Coding
- Medical Records & Health Information
