INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

Information Technology (IT) includes jobs that design, implement, manage, and safeguard technology. It uses computers, software, networks, servers, and other technology to manage and store data. Jobs in IT fall into 4 career categories below-example jobs are also listed.

- ⇒ Example job in Information Support & Services: video game designers
- ⇒ Example job in Network Systems: computer network support specialist
- ⇒ Example job in Programming & Software Development: computer programmers
- ⇒ Example job in Web & Digital Communication : web developers

Training Requirement: Varies. Example jobs above require an Associates Degree or less

Median Annual Wage for Example Jobs (Wages are for 2020):

- Video Game Designers: \$77,200 (or \$37.12/hr)
- Computer Network Support SPC: \$65,450 (or \$31.47/hr)
- Computer Programmers: \$89,190 (or \$42.88/hr)
- Web Developer: \$77,200 (or \$37.12/hr)

SWFI provided low- to middle-skilled parents opportunities to advance in their careers in high-growth or in high-demand industries-including health care, advanced manufacturing, and information technology – while addressing barriers related to accessing training and employment faced by those with child care responsibilities.

The training directory was produced by SWFI's Trainers Network. The Network, led by the SWFI partner, Action for a Better Community, Inc, consisted primarily of training programs, as well as workforce system organizations, government agencies and community-based organizations in Monroe County, NY that came together to address training–related community needs.

The SWFI program ends on June 30, 2021.
