### HEALTH CARE

**Health Care** relates to planning, managing, and providing therapeutic and wellness services, diagnostic services, health informatics, support services, and biotechnology research and development. The primary function of the healthcare industry is to treat patients facing illness or injury—whether to cure or rehabilitate from a condition, to maintain wellness, or to provide comfort or palliative care to persons dealing with incurable conditions. Many careers in healthcare offer the opportunity to make an important difference in people's lives.

**Training Requirement:** Credentials are paramount in this industry, as healthcare careers are closely identified with the level of education required, certifications, and licensure. Example jobs above require high school education with formal or on the job training, while other example jobs requires an associates degree or bachelor's degree.

#### Median Annual Wage for Example Jobs ( Wages are for 2020):

- Medical Secretaries: \$37,350 (or \$17.96/hr)
- Physical Therapy Aides: \$28,450 (or \$13.68/hr)
- Dental Assistants: \$41,180 (or \$19.80/hr)
- Certified Nurse Assistants: \$30,850 (or \$14.83/hr)
- Registered Nurses: \$75,330 (or \$36.22/hr)
- Licensed Practical Nurses: \$48,820 (or \$23.47/hr)

**Demand:** The healthcare industry is booming and ten-year projections indicate continued strong growth. In fact, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics projects that nearly one in seven Americans will be employed in the healthcare and social assistance industry by 2028.

The Network, led by the SWFI partner, Action for a Better Community, Inc., consisted primarily of training programs, as well as workforce system organizations, government agencies and community-based organizations in Monroe County, NY that came together to address training—related community needs.

The SWFI program ends on June 30, 2021.
